What to Do if Your Country Does Not Have an ESEO Delegation

If your country is not listed above or does not currently have an established ESEO delegation, please follow these steps:

1. Contact the ESEO International Board:

The Board can assist you with initiating the creation of a national delegation, provide guidance on forming a selection committee, and help integrate your country into the ESEO community.

2. National Delegation Formation Requirements:

- A small team of 2-3 professionals such as university professors, educators, or researchers with expertise in sociology or related fields.
- Connections with academic institutions or sociological organizations within your country.
- Commitment to a transparent and fair selection process based on essay submissions or other forms of sociological writing.

3. Starting the Selection Process:

Your delegation will be responsible for informing prospective participants about submission guidelines, deadlines, and selection criteria. Delegations may collaborate with local schools, universities, or research centers to reach potential participants.
